COMPREHENSIVE, COMPASSIONATE SOLUTIONS

● PSYCHIATRY & THERAPY

SalusCare offers **therapy and psychiatry services** for children and adults, both on site and via telehealth.

● CASE MANAGEMENT

Links individuals with serious mental health, substance use, or co-occurring disorders to community resources to assist individuals in living autonomously and **reaching their recovery goals**.

● SUBSTANCE USE TREATMENT AND RECOVERY

SalusCare provides care for adults diagnosed with substance use disorders, most of which are directed by a physician.

TYPES OF CARE INCLUDE

● Day Treatment &

Extended Day Treatment

Group and individual therapy is available for those who are working or otherwise unable to participate in a residential therapy setting.

● Evening Treatment

For employed adults who need intensive treatment during the evening hours.

● Detoxification

An individualized and supportive approach to substance use disorders, incorporating physician supervised medical treatments, group and individual therapy, pet and aroma therapy. Detox care is tailored to the patients' strengths, needs and abilities.

● Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)

Provides outpatient treatment for alcohol use disorders and/or opioid use disorders that includes the use of medication along with counseling and other support.

● Maternal Assistance

Assists pregnant and postpartum women with specialized treatment options including substance use treatment, linkage to medical, psycho-social and natural resources to assist in a healthy pregnancy and birth.

● FORENSIC DIVERSION

Aims to prevent unnecessary institutionalization or criminalization of individuals with serious mental illnesses and co-occurring substance use disorders through advocacy, state-approved competency restoration training, and court system collaboration.

● RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

● Vince Smith Center

A **24/7 therapeutic care and temporary residence** for teens with substance diagnoses. Specialized clinicians work alongside caregivers and other providers, fostering a team approach to treatment. Additionally, an in-house classroom allows them to continue their education through the School District of Lee County.

● Transitional Living Campus (TLC)

Provides a short-term inpatient residential treatment for adults with a substance use disorder, as well as step down into a **transitional home** which affords a longer stay for individuals to reach their recovery goals.

● SalusCare Place

A long-term, accredited, peer-led, supportive and **safe housing community** for residents in recovery who are pursuing goals such as gainful employment or continued education.

● CRISIS STABILIZATION

For adults and children requiring psychiatric emergency level of care, particularly persons who may pose a risk of harm to themselves or others, SalusCare offers **secure, inpatient psychiatric services** through our crisis stabilization units. Our compassionate, talented and well qualified team collaborates to manage the immediate emergency, but also to devise a comprehensive treatment plan for discharge back into the community, with linkage to critical psychiatric, psycho-social, and natural resources to ensure wellness and success.
